

## BELARUS

The result of qualifications is calculated on the basis of:

■ **certificate of secondary comprehensive education** (по аттестату об окончании среднего образования) – **as basic level**

or

■ **additional exams: CT/CE** – **as extended level**

Results will be calculated as follows:

<b>Certificate of secondary comprehensive education</b> – treated as <b>basic level</b> – maximum grade "10"	<b>Exams: CT/CE</b> – treated as <b>extended level</b> – maximum grade "100"
<b>The conversion factor is 0.6</b>  <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• grade <b>10</b> = <b>100 p.</b></li><li>• grade <b>9</b> = <b>90 p.</b></li><li>• grade <b>8</b> = <b>80 p.</b></li><li>• grade <b>7</b> = <b>70 p.</b></li><li>• grade <b>6</b> = <b>60 p.</b></li><li>• grade <b>5</b> = <b>50 p.</b></li><li>• grade <b>4</b> = <b>40 p.</b></li></ul> <p>The obtained points are multiplied by factor <b>0,6</b>, for example:</p> <p><b>100 x 0,6 = 60</b></p>	<b>The conversion factor</b>  The exam result is converted on a <b>1:1 basis</b>  <b>e.g. 79 x 1 = 79</b>

When a foreign language or a required subject are included both in a secondary comprehensive education certificate and CT/CE examination, this option is considered which, when calculated, leads to a higher grade.
